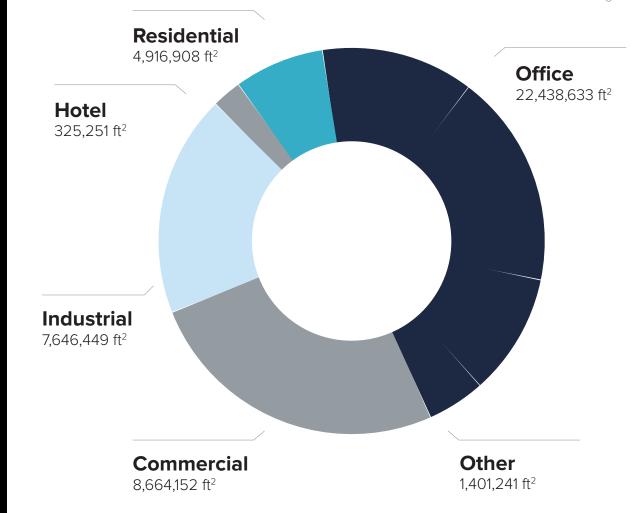


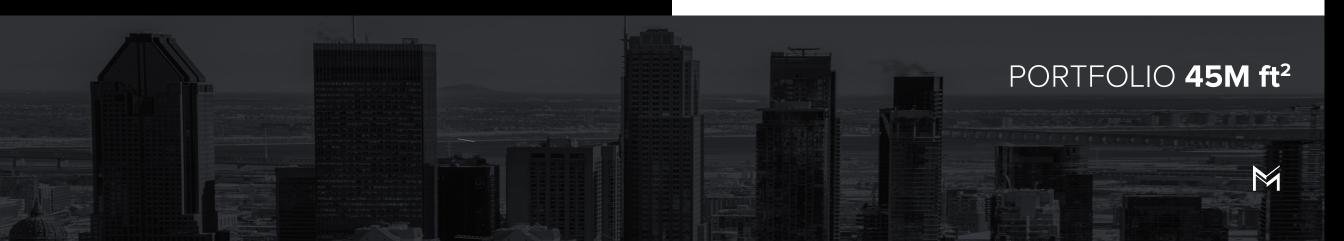

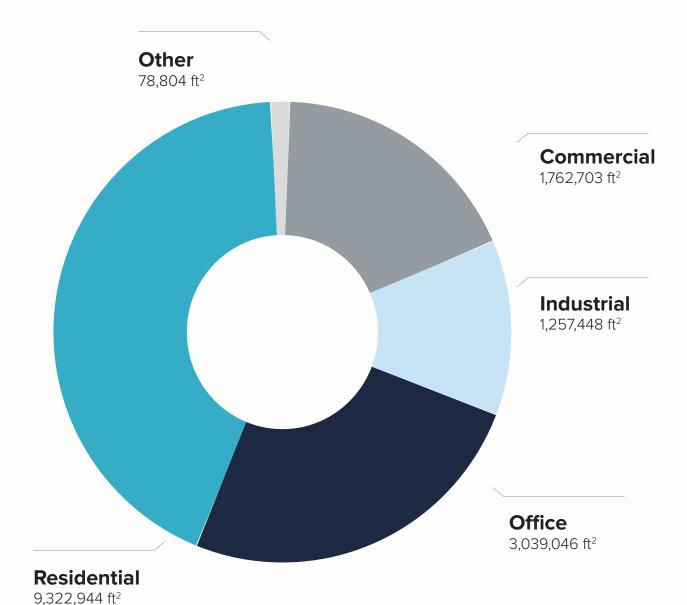

Our team, composed of more than 500 professionals, adheres to the highest standards of governance and sustainable development, solidifying our position as a pillar of the Canadian real estate sector.





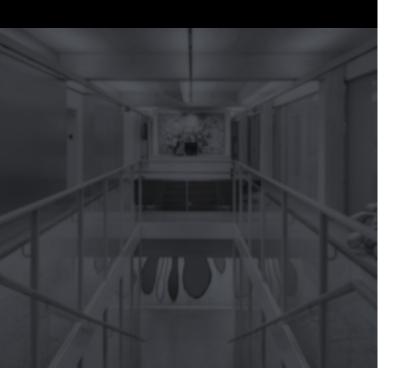

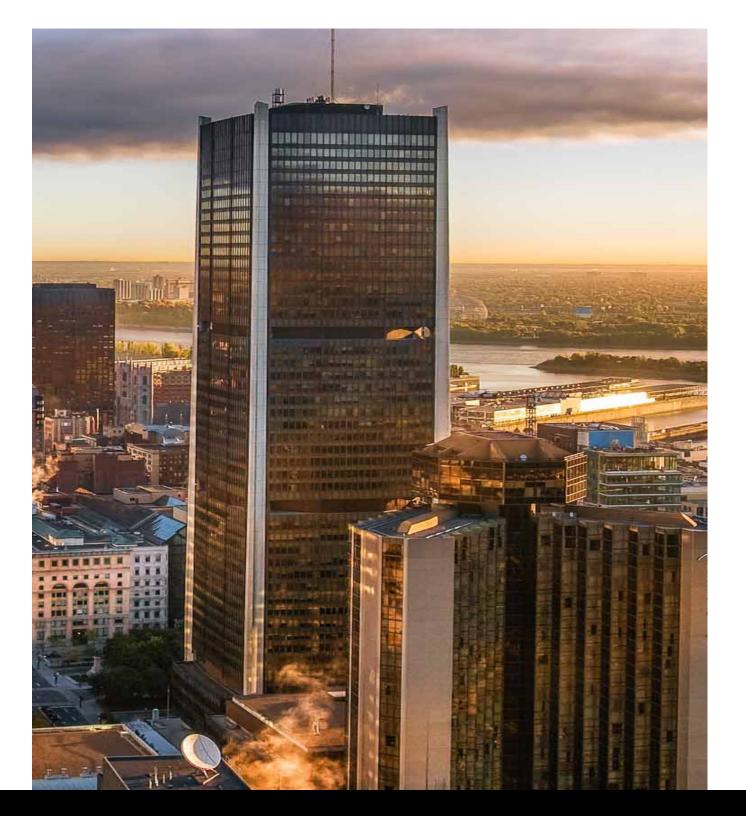












PLACE VICTORIA

800 PLACE VICTORIA

True emblem of Downtown Montréal, this 47-storey Class A building is located at its heart, providing access to the Montreal underground. Built in 1965, its high-end layout, its location and its two-storey trade fair makes it a prestigious address.

A true emblem of downtown Montreal, this Class A building stands 47 stories high and is located in the heart of downtown. It is directly connected to the Square Victoria metro station and the RESO (Montreal's underground city). Built in 1965, it has an area of over one million square feet. Its high-end layout, prime location, and two-story commercial fair make it a prestigious address. The food court can accommodate 575 seated people, and the promenade features more than twenty shops, restaurants, and services.

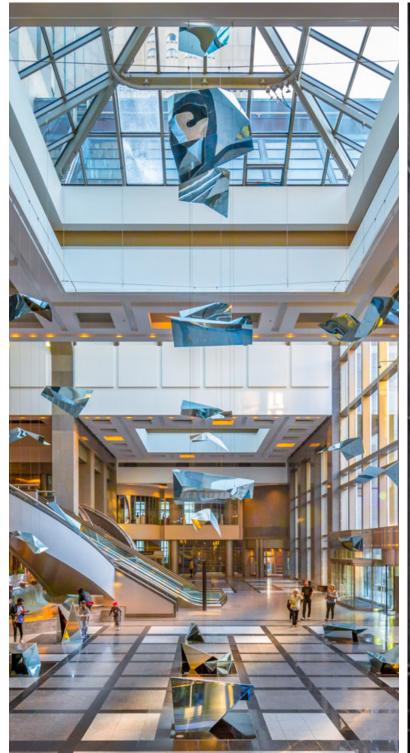

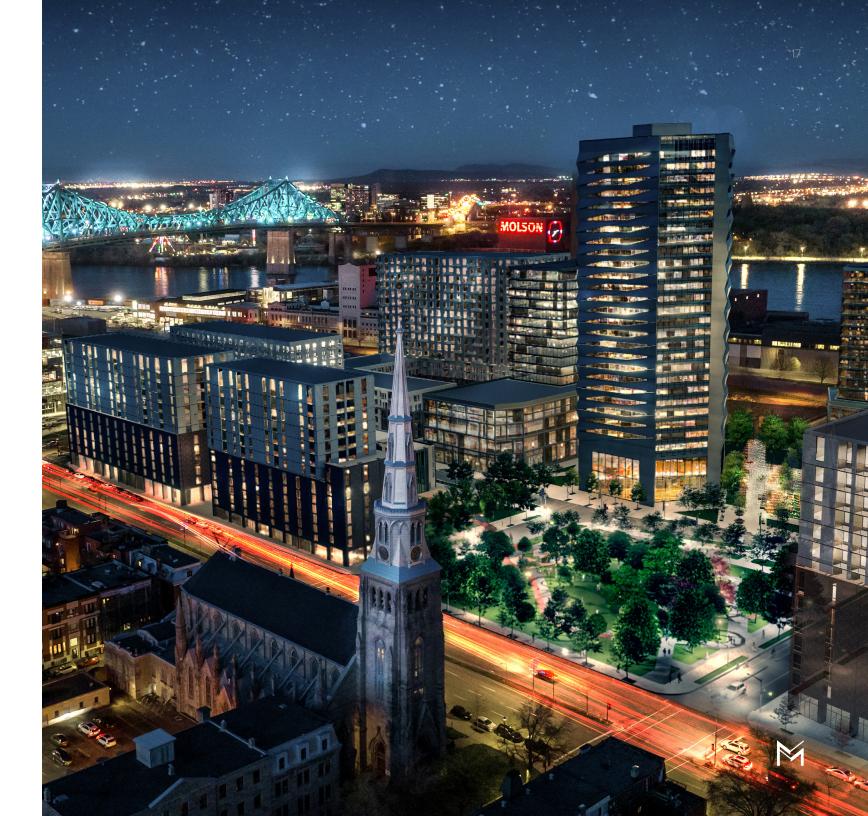

It consists of two buildings: the newer one, a unique 26-storey tower primarily housing hotel rooms and suites, and the Nordheimer, dating back to 1888, which houses conference and event spaces.

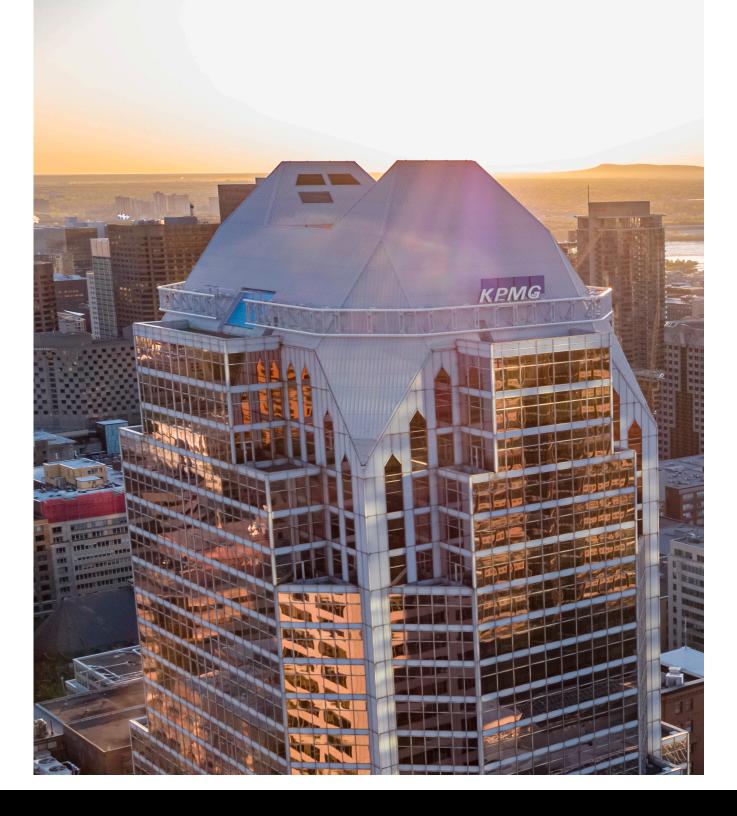

Its ornate finish and elegant design add to its grandiosity. Indeed, its imposing Corinthian columns and its polished, brass gates which are engraved with the coat of arms of Canada's 10 provinces highlight its grand nature. In addition, the sumptuous neoclassical hall and its 30-foot ceiling, laden with refined leaves of gold, bronze and brass leave visitors out of breath and add to the overall lavishness of this structure. The elevators are made in rich marble and sandstone and lead to all 26 floors, protected by the ornamental plaster ceilings and the gleaming walls.
